

## **144,000: 17 – See You in Paradise**

Its thorny leaves and scarlet berries, like drops of blood, symbolize the Master's suffering during his Passion, so in northern Europe it is called "Christ's Thorn." It also is known as the "holy tree." Herbalists have used its powdered leaves to make a tea or infusion that treats respiratory illnesses, which are caused by willfulness, being selfish and denying one's Self. The Bach flower remedy Holly is said to soothe those who are angry due to hatred, suspicion, envy or jealousy.

To enter the garden, therefore, drink in the green essence of the holly or holy tree of life that you are in I Am consciousness. Let go of any lingering selfish desire or any anger that you have about what others have done to you. Turn your other cheek and return love for hatred. Ask for forgiveness of your jealousy, even as you forgive those who are envious of you. In your time of Passion before Easter, cross out any thorny situation in your soul. See yourself as whole.

As you judge, so are you judged. By loving and forgiving others, you enter the Green Garden of Grace, wherein Spirit bestows His-Her love upon you a hundred times beyond what you think you deserve. In the holy hush of this healing haven, our Parent gives you every healing power and every opportunity to see glory on each person's face, including your own. So be it.
